Help was offered for typical repairs including simple adjustment of brakes and gears, fixing punctures or replacing inner tubes and adjustment of bikes to suit the rider. Qualified mechanics were also be on hand to advise members of the public how to carry out routine cycle

maintenance themselves.

The Blacon Festival is an annual family fun day celebration and this year had an all-American theme to mark Independence Day, with a Rodeo bull, American burger stand, laser clay shooting and a special workshop from Cheshire Jets basketball on the day.
