Tarvin Hub, Route 18:

Starting at Tarvin Road A51-
-Join Littleton Hub at Pearl Lane P1.

Littleton Hub Route 19:

Starting at Pearl Lane-
-Join Hoole Hub at Hoole Lane Bridge P2.

Hoole Hub Route 20:

Starting at Hoole Lane-
-Arrive at Chester City Centre.

Mickle Trafford Route 21:

Starting on Warrington Road-
-Join Guilden Sutton Hub at Guilden Sutton Lane P3.

Guilden Sutton Route 22:

Starting at Guilden Sutton Lane-
Join Hoole Hub at Hoole Lane Bridge P2.

Newton Hub Route 23:

Starting on Kent Road-
-Join Upton Hub at Newton Lane access point P4.

Upton Hub Route 24:

Starting at Wealstone Lane-
Arrive at Chester City Centre..
